Discovery

AHI Connects: Cooking Lesson.

A chef shares tips for making authentic *pesto alla genovese* and *focaccia*.

Nice: Capital of the French Riviera.

Visit the Musée Marc Chagall, host to the artist's most important biblical works. Then gain insight into Nice's history on a walking tour of the old town. Soak up vistas of Parc de la Colline du Château and the Promenade des Anglais, the seaside walkway. Pass by homes of nobility and enjoy the ambiance of the Cours Saleya Market, a bustling hub with flowers, produce, olive oils and curiosities.

Monaco's Glamor. Monaco is a sovereign city-state on the French Riviera known for its lavish lifestyles, palm trees and the Monaco Grand Prix. Visit the Monaco Cathedral and watch the changing of the guard outside the Prince's Palace. Venture into Monte Carlo, Monaco's most well-known quarter, followed by timeless Èze where you can roam the medieval streets.

Riviera Gems. Drive to Saint-Jean-Cap-Ferrat, playground to billionaires, politicians and actors. Visit the palatial Villa Ephrussi, built by Baroness Béatrice de Rothschild. In the resort town of Villefranche-sur-Mer, witness the renowned yacht-filled harbor.

Riv to Riv. Depart France's lovely Côte d'Azur and transfer to Genoa, Italy. Here, admire unparalleled views from the top of Spianata Castelletto. Walk along the Via Garibaldi, and see Columbus House and the striped façade of the Genoa Cathedral.

Sestri Levante. A walking tour reveals the many architectural treasures and charming palazzos of this waterfront jewel.

The Cinque Terre. Discover rugged cliffs and pastel-hued villages while traveling from Portovenere to Manarola. Continue by boat to witness Corniglia and Vernazza from the water and savor lunch at a seaside *trattoria*.

The Italian Riviera. Travel to the seaside resort of Rapallo, followed by a cruise to the sunny playground of Portofino. Continue gliding on azure seas to Santa Margherita for an insightful walking tour.
